Oodnadatta is an isolated outback town, 200 kms north east of Coober Pedy and over 1,000 kms from Adelaide. The rough, stony road is best travelled in a four wheel drive vehicle. The Oodnadatta UC faith community (with support from UAICC Regional Council) has identified the need for a 4WD vehicle to provide support for the ministry in their community.

The Oodnadatta Story:

- The faith community grew out of the partnership with Frontier Services
- 29 baptisms at Easter 2011
- Bringing young people to SAYCO in Adelaide
- Christian ministry and theological studies
- Involvement in the About Face program
- Host community for Stepping Stone and About Face events
- Sharing ministry throughout the APY lands
