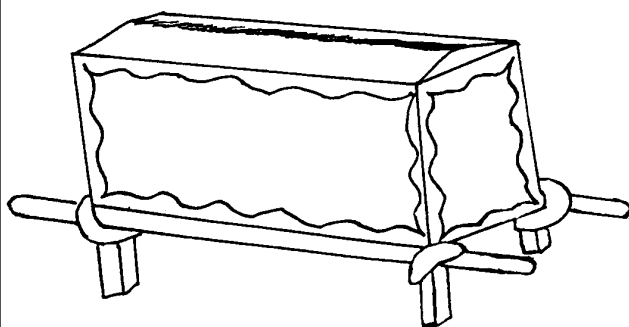


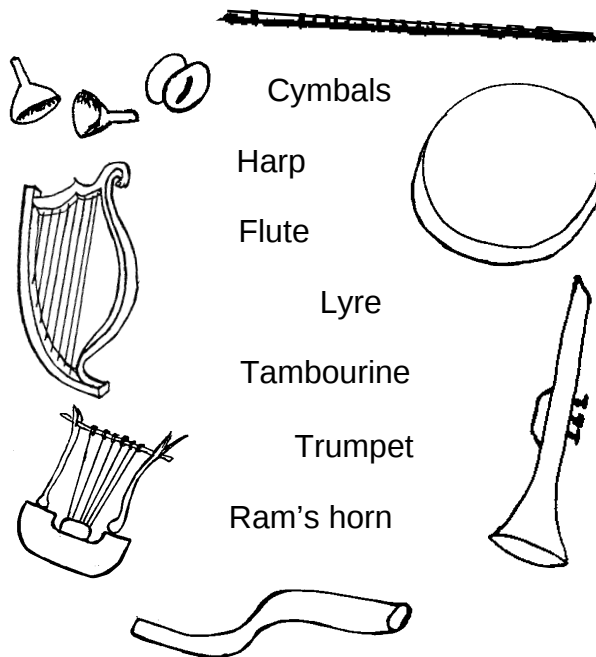
Ark of the Covenant

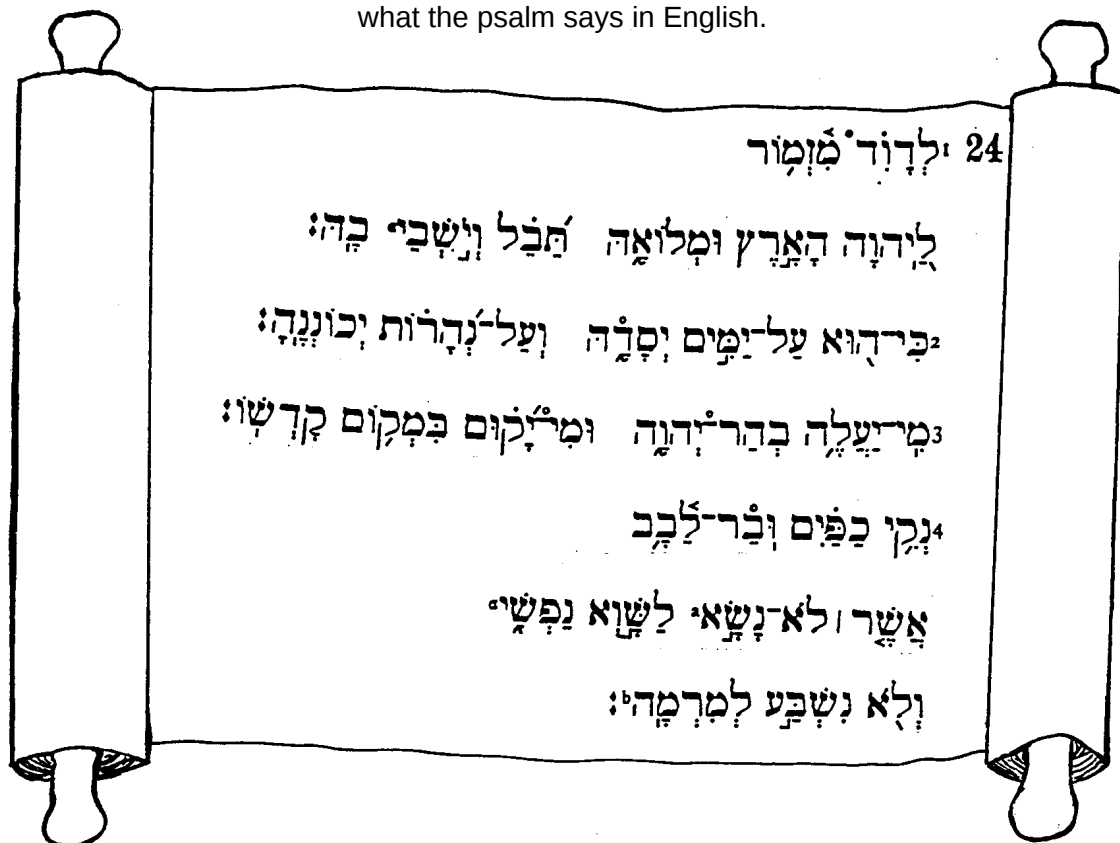
Musical Instruments of King David's time
