Instructions:

- ♦ Photocopy Wiggle Woggle onto A4 paper.
- ♦ Cut around outline of large square.
- ♦ Place writing side down
- ♦ Fold corners towards centre of square. (Use the triangular lines as fold lines.) **Colour, number and clues** triangles will be face up.
- ♦ Turn over.
- ♦ Fold corners towards centre of square. **Number and clues** triangles will be face up.

To prepare paper game for play,

- ♦ Fold in half one way, then fold in half the other way
- ♦ Slip thumb and forefinger of each hand under the flaps of paper with colour words on them.
- ♦ Practice closing then opening the paper game one way then the other.



To play: Play in pairs:

- ♦ Player 1: Choose a colour.
- ♦ Player 2: Open and close for each letter of the chosen colour. (e.g. Y-E-L-L-O-W)
- ♦ Player 1: Choose an inside number.
- ♦ Player 2: Open and close for the number chosen. (e.g. 1-2-3-4-5-6)
- ♦ Player 1: Choose a clue word. (e.g. Anger)
- ♦ Player 2: Spells the word while opening and closing for each letter. (e.g. A-N-G-E-R)
- ♦ Player 1: Chose another word, then try to guess what the writer of Ephesians said in relation to that word.
- ♦ Player 2: Open up see if Player 1 was right.
