Peace Specs

Date: 26th April, 2009 Reading: Luke 24:36b-48:
Peace be with you

Jesus came into the world as the Prince of peace, and his last words with his disciples began with "Peace be with you..."

Children can use these 'specs' as their 'peace glasses' — reminding them to look at the world through a peaceful framework. Challenge them to consciously think of ways to be peaceful when they wear the glasses

You will need:

- ♦ photocopied glasses pattern
- ♦ light-weight cardboard
- ♦ coloured felt pens, including silver and gold
- ♦ feathers and other decorative notions
- ♦ scissors, glue
- ♦ hat elastic

Preparation:

- ♦ Photocopy the glasses onto light-weight card.

What to do:

- ♦ Children can colour in the specs as they wish.
- ♦ Cut around bold lines, including the inside of the glasses eye-holes.
- ♦ Decorate as desired with extra. bits & pieces.
- ♦ Attach some hat elastic through the black dots at the sides, to fit the child's head.



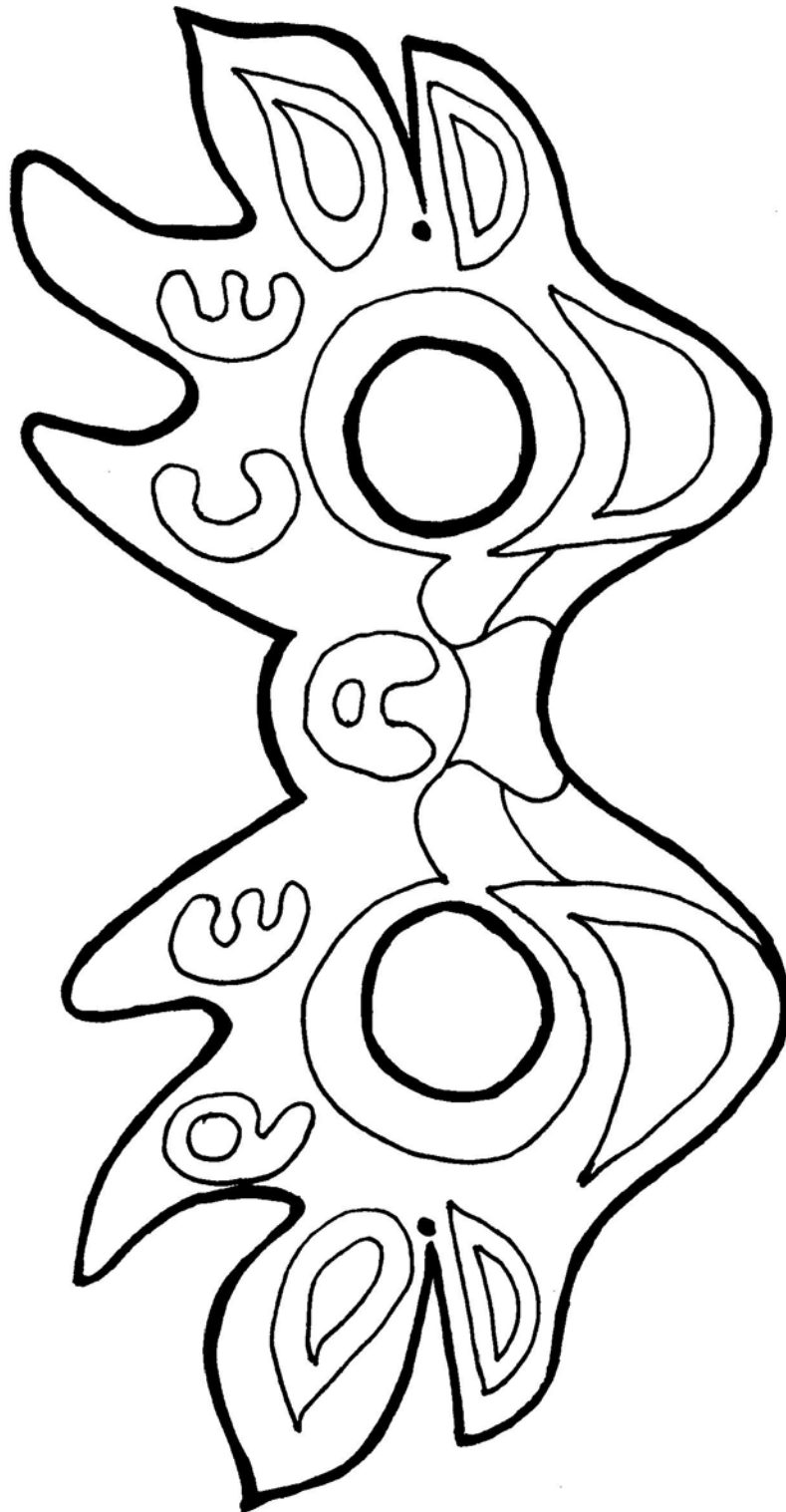
