A Woman is Healed

Arising woman

You will need:

- ♦ light card
- ♦ templates
- ♦ coloured pencils
- ♦ scissors
- ♦ split pins
- ♦ Optional: material for the woman's clothes and the pillow

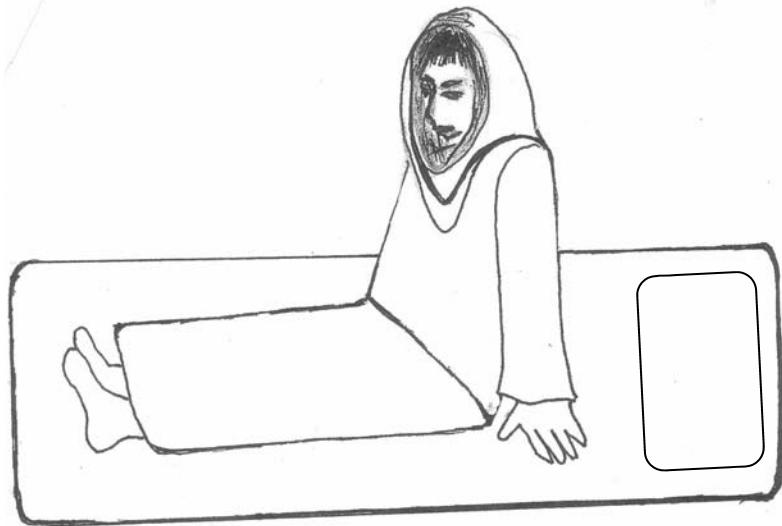
Preparation:

Photocopy templates onto light card.
'Bed' cards: 12cm x 4cm

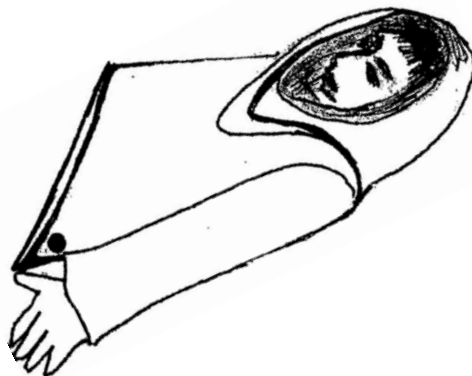
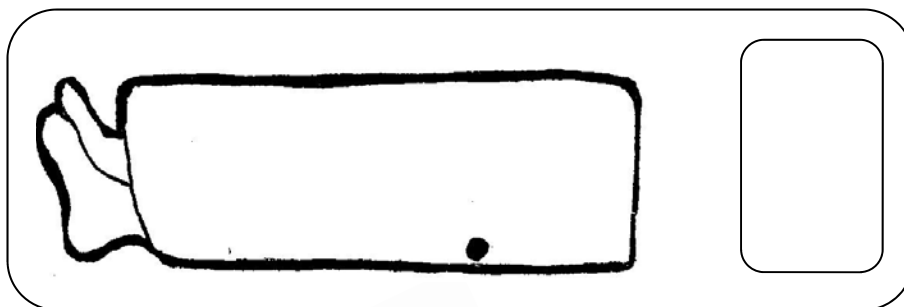
Method:

- ♦ Cut around figures in templates.
- ♦ Colour in the woman's clothes and pillow.
- ♦ Optional: glue on material for the skirt and the pillow.
- ♦ Attach top half of body to bottom half with split pin at black dots. Arrange so she is lying down at start of story.

Help Simon's mother-in-law to get up and serve them a meal after Jesus heals her.



Children can tell the story with Simon's mother-in-law in prone position. When they get to the part where Jesus takes her by the hand, they can pull on her hand and sit her up. The split pin should allow her to bend at the waist.



This craft can also be used for the story of Tabitha/Dorcas, whom Peter brought back to life. (Acts 9: 36-43)
