Reading: Mark 4: 26-34

Mustard/Small Seed Pendant

You will need:

- ♦ walnut shells
- ♦ moss, dried flowers, herbs etc
- ♦ mustard seed (available in supermarket spices and herbs section) – if not available use other small round seeds
- ♦ wool
- ♦ paint & paintbrush (optional)
- ♦ glue
- ♦ drill

Preparation:

Drill 2 holes in top of each walnut shell as shown in diagram.



Method:

- ♦ Paint the outside of the shell – or leave natural if preferred.
- ♦ Make a nest inside the shell with moss, dried flowers, herbs etc.
- ♦ Glue mustard seed or other seeds inside shell where it/ they will be easily visible.
- ♦ Thread wool through holes and tie at an appropriate length.

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
