Ears to hear

You will need:

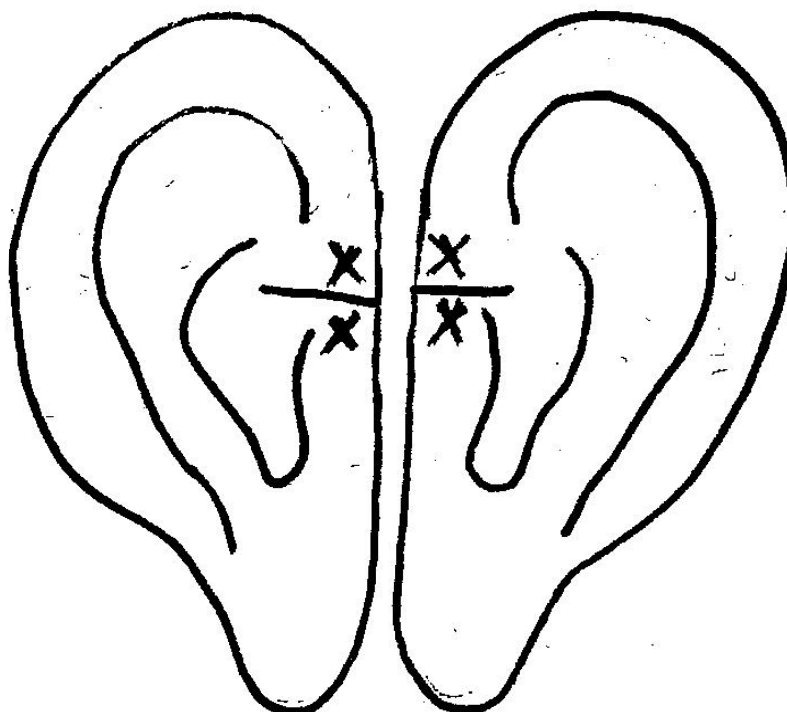
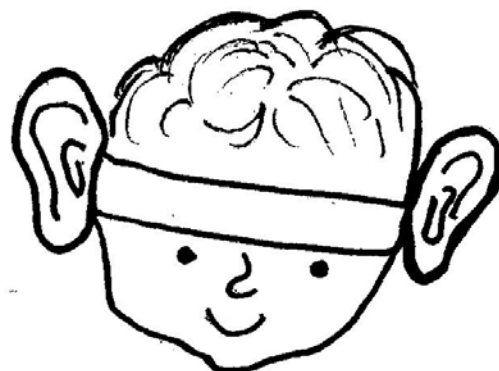
- ♦ Cardboard strip to fit each child's head
- ♦ cardboard for ears
- ♦ scissors
- ♦ stapler and staples
- ♦ ear patterns

What to do:

- Photocopy ears onto cardboard (enlarge if you want very big ears)
- Cut headband to fit child's head. Staple.
- Cut ears out.
- Cut along line between crosses.
- Overlap the edges so that one cross fits over the other. Staple.
- Staple or tape ears to headband.
- You can write on the headband a verse or phrase: e.g.

Jesus healed a man who couldn't hear.
