

Who are you, Jesus?

Christ the Lighthouse

You will need:

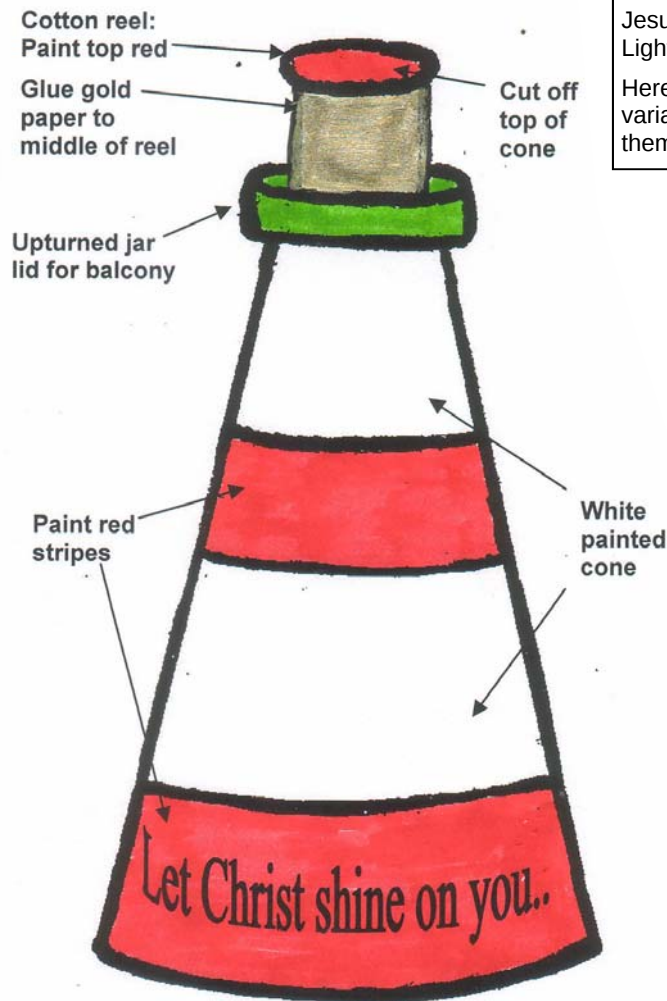
- ♦ cardboard cones
 - ☞ You can buy them at places like **That's Not Garbage** or **The Reverse Garbage Truck**
 - ☞ or save your own overlocker thread spools
 - ☞ or make simple cones from ordinary cardboard.
 - ☞ The cones need to have a flat top on which to sit the 'balcony' and the light.
- ♦ red and white acrylic paint
- ♦ bottle or jar caps slightly larger than the flat top of the cone
- ♦ old fashioned cotton reels (if you can find any), film canisters or something similar (party popper cases would do quite well)
- ♦ holographic gold paper or self-adhesive plastic (book cover stuff...)
- ♦ craft glue
- ♦ Printed Label: *Let Christ shine on you... Live as children of the light ...*
NB: Label should fit around the base of the lighthouse; make sure it is not too long.

Preparation:

1. Print labels (on your computer) and run off enough for each child to have one. Use a large enough print for it to be easily seen, but make sure it is not too long to fit the circumference of the cone.
2. Cut the gold paper strips to fit the "light" you are using. [See **Light in What to do**]

Jesus is called the Light of the world.
Here's a lighthouse variation on the theme...



What to do:

- ♦ Paint the cone white.
- ♦ When it dries the children might like to paint red stripes on it, or a red door.
- ♦ Glue the lid to the flat top of the cone to make the balcony.
- ♦ **Light:** Cut a strip of holographic gold paper or self-adhesive plastic to fit around the cotton reel or film canister or party popper. Glue or adhere in place. [If using party poppers, the children might like to make a flag to fly in the top of it.]
- ♦ Glue the light to the top of the 'balcony' lid. Optional: Paint the top of the light red.
- ♦ Paste the Bible text label round the base of the lighthouse.

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
