

Who are you, Jesus?

Cardboard Candlesticks

Suitable for younger children.

Messy but relatively easy – suitable for younger children to mid-primary. Have plenty of damp rags on hand for wiping sticky fingers. Younger children may need help with the flame.

Materials:

- cardboard tube (toilet paper roll size) for each child
- A4 yellow construction paper (or any other colour that you fancy!)
- flames pre-cut from red or orange paper or use foil wrapping paper (or use foil chocolate wrappers) for a fancier effect
- scissors
- sticky tape
- glue
- coloured markers
- stickers (optional)

Lectionary Crafts

Date: 13th September, 2009 Reading: **Mark 8: 27–38**: Who do people say I am?

Jesus is called the Light of the World, the Good Shepherd, Prince of Peace. Here are some fun candle crafts to explore the Light of the World theme.



Preparation:

- Cut out flame shapes with either red or orange construction paper, enough for one-two flames for each child (one large, one smaller to fit inside the larger one). You can also use foil paper or foil chocolate wrappers for a fancier effect.
- You may want to pre-cut the coloured paper to fit around the cardboard roll, especially for younger children.

Method:

- Roll the construction paper around the cardboard roll and tape or glue it down.
- Glue the flame to the inside of the roll so that it stands up out of the hole.
- Decorate the candle with stickers or write a Bible verse: e.g. John 8: 12:

Jesus said, I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will have the light of life and will never walk in darkness."


Fancy version:

Materials:

- cardboard tubes: can be half the size of a toilet roll
- gold foil wrapping paper (or use foil chocolate wrappers)
- acrylic paints or coloured paper
- PVA glue
- tin lids, gold coloured if possible
- dried or artificial flowers, gumnuts, ribbon, etc. to decorate

Method:

- Apply a coat of paint (or two) to the tube, or to save time, use coloured paper and glue it on as above.
- ◆ Cut a flame shape for the candle from a sheet of gold foil wrapping paper. Attach the flame to the candlestick by gluing or taping the lower edge to the inside of the tube. [Metallic chocolate wrappers make interesting 'flames']



Write 'Jesus Light of the World' around the top of the candle.

- Run a circle of PVA glue the size of the tube inside the lid. Stand the 'candle' in the glue.
- Add some more glue onto the lid surface around the 'candle'.
- Decorate around the base of the 'candle' with gumnuts, dried flowers, and other small decorations which sit in the glue.
- Optional: Glue some ribbon or braid around the outside edge of the lid.
- Allow to dry.
