

Jesus, the Good Shepherd

Sheep Fridge Magnet or Brooch

Materials:

- ♦ 8cm circles of white card,
- ♦ lightweight card for head and feet (can be of a different colour than white if you wish);
- ♦ cotton wool balls, eyes,
- ♦ self-adhesive magnetic strips, or safety pins or brooch pins;
- ♦ scissors, craft glue; *optional*: sticky tape

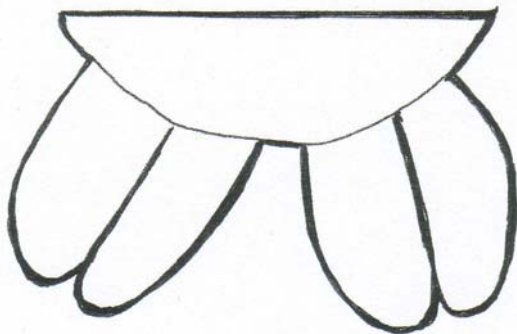
Preparation:

Photocopy head and feet onto lightweight card

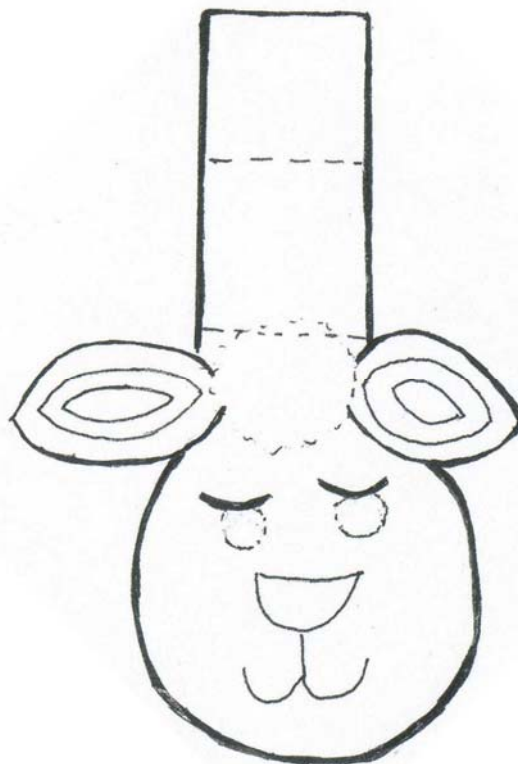
Method:

- ♦ Cut out white circle
- ♦ Glue or sticky tape the feet to the back of the circle at the base.
- ♦ Fold head flap on dotted lines so the head will hang down over the body. Glue or sticky tape in position at the top of the card.
- ♦ Fluff the cotton wool balls out a little.
- ♦ Glue cotton wool onto main circle so that it is covered, including under the head, and also a little in between the ears.
- ♦ Glue eyes in place.
- ♦ Stick magnetic strip to the back of the sheep to make a frig magnet, or glue brooch pin, or sticky-tape safety pin, to the back to make a brooch.
