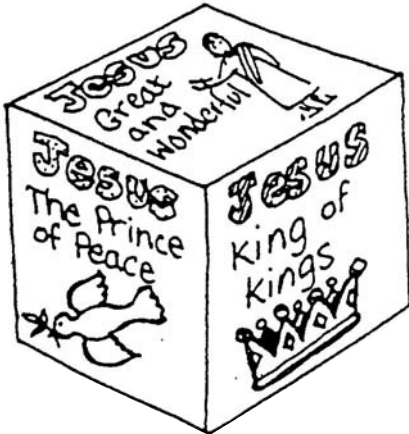


Christ the King

Jesus Cube

Date: 23rd November 2008 Reading: Matthew 25: 31-46:
Reign of Christ/Christ the King Sunday

Meditate on the nature and message of Jesus through this cube of names and images of the one who came to be Emmanuel: God with us, Prince of Peace, Saviour of the world. This activity will lead nicely into Advent next week.



You will need:

- ♦ photocopied template (see next page for full-sized template)
- ♦ light-weight cardboard
- ♦ coloured felt pens, pencils
- ♦ scissors
- ♦ glue



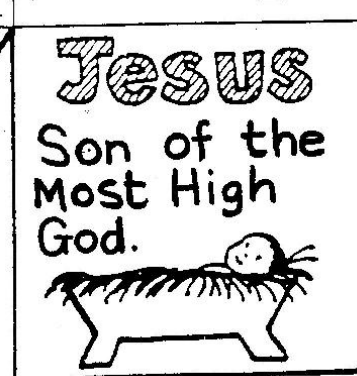
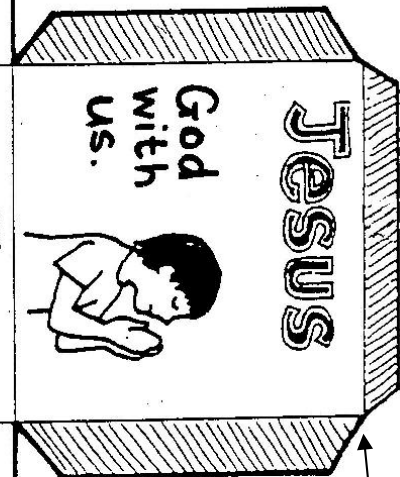
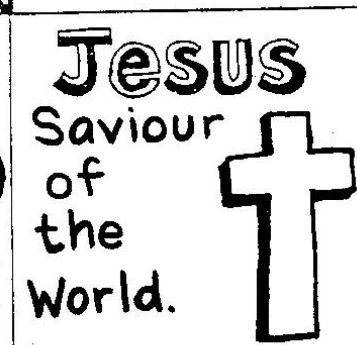
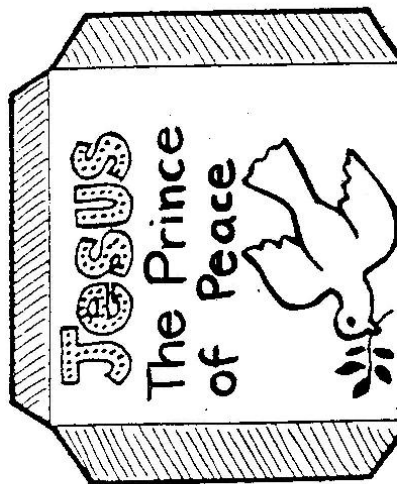
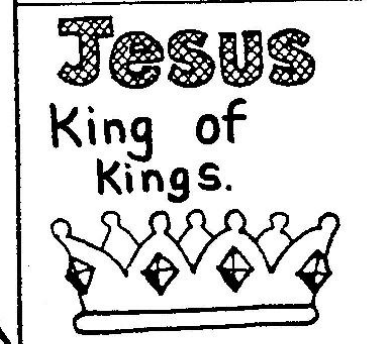
← If you don't glue the top flap the cube can be used as a box.

Preparation:

- ♦ Photocopy the page onto light-weight card.

What to do:

- ♦ Colour in the pictures.
- ♦ Cut around bold lines.
- ♦ Fold tabs and sections.
- ♦ Glue together.
- ♦ If you glue a thread or loop coming out of one corner the box can be hung as a decoration.
- ♦ If you don't glue the top flap the cube can be used as a box.
