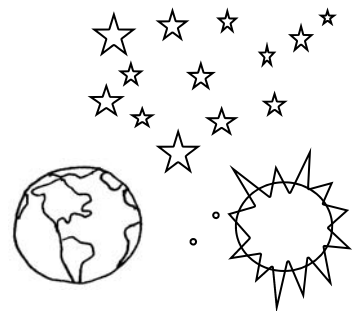


Psalm 139: known and loved

you _____ me with your hand.

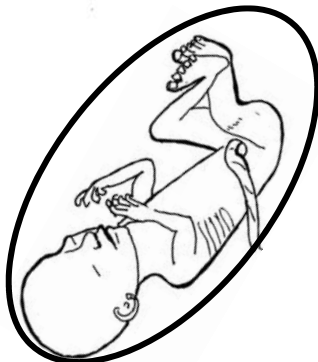
Your knowledge of me is too deep;
