

Finger Puppets

These puppets are the simplest of all finger puppets to make and fit onto a child's finger. These figures can be adapted to tell any Bible story.

However, as they are made of paper or cardboard they will not stand up to prolonged or rough use.

You will need:

- ♦ white construction paper or thin cardboard
- ♦ finger puppet patterns (see *this page and next*)
- ♦ textas to colour puppets
- ♦ scissors, sticky tape/glue

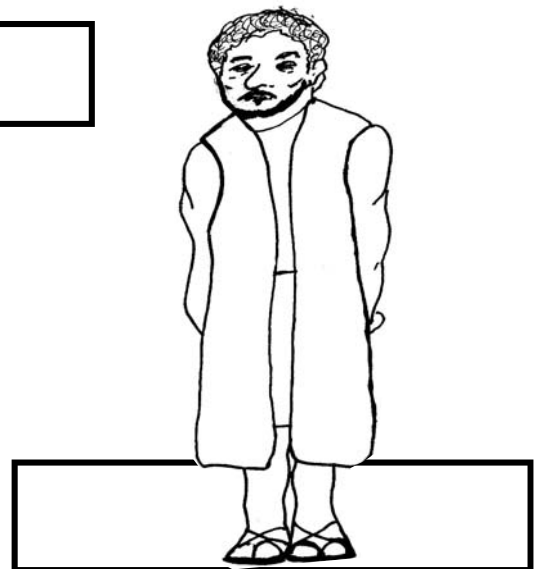
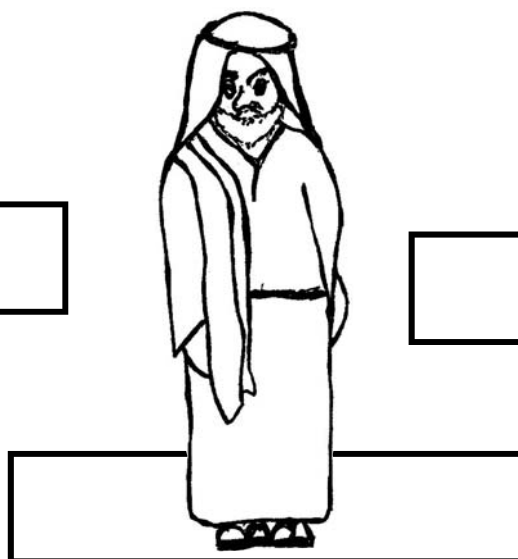
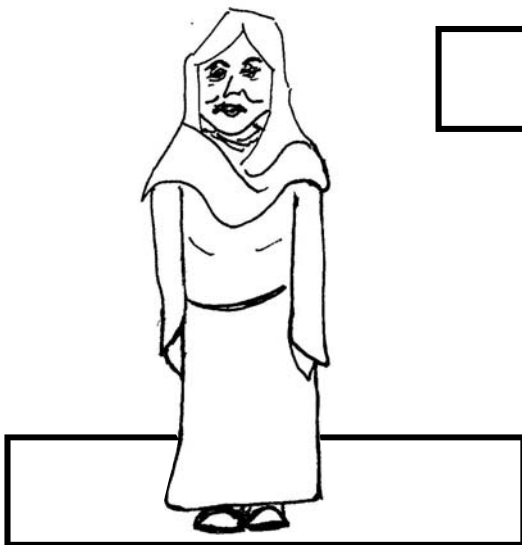
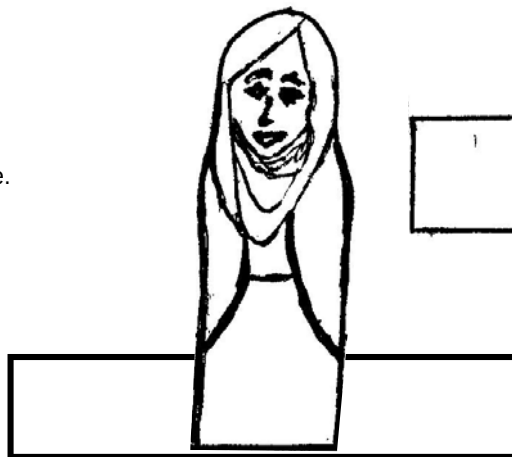
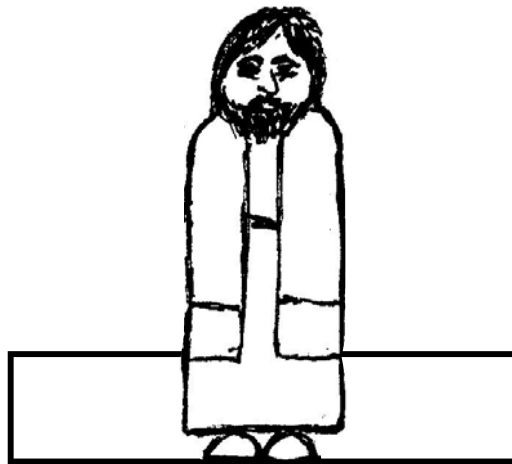
Preparation:

What to do:

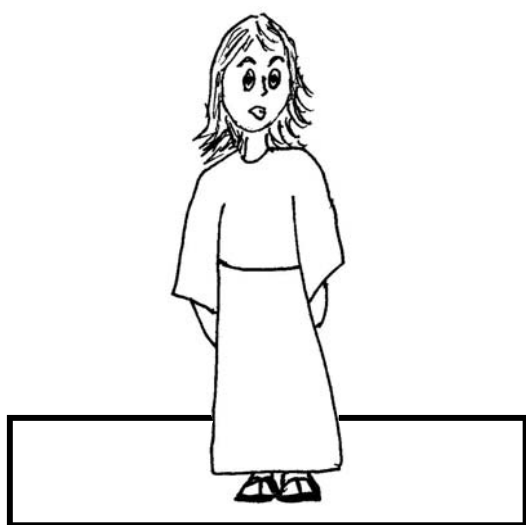
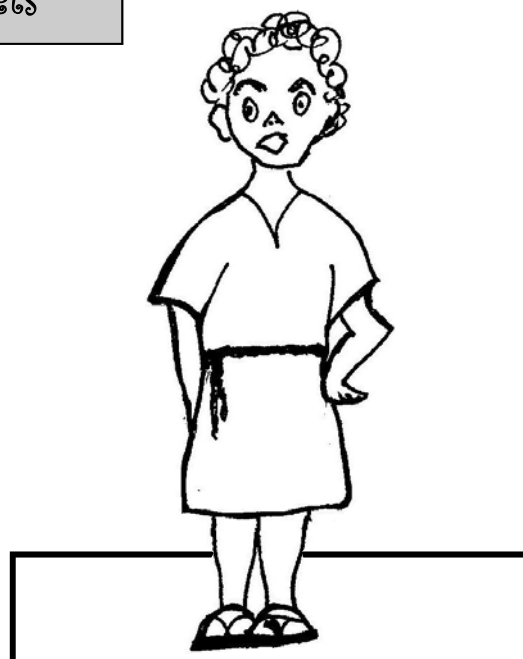
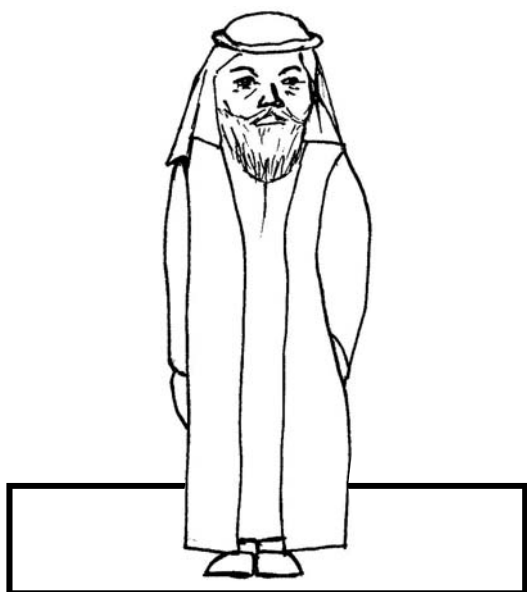
- ♦ Colour puppets
- ♦ Cut out puppets
- ♦ Fit puppets to the child's finger and glue or sticky tape the tabs in place.

Children can use them to tell and act out the stories to each other.



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
