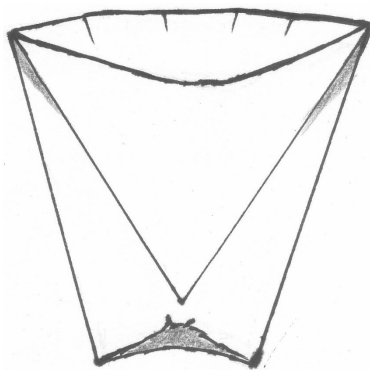

PAPER CUP

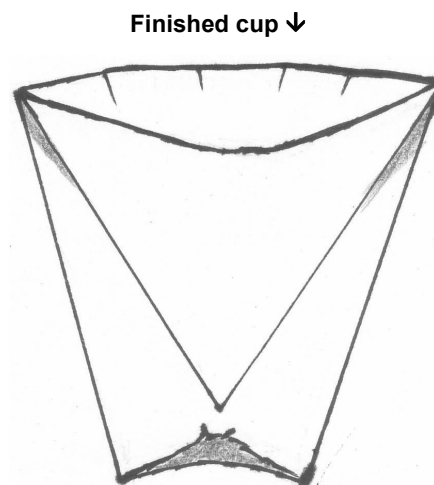
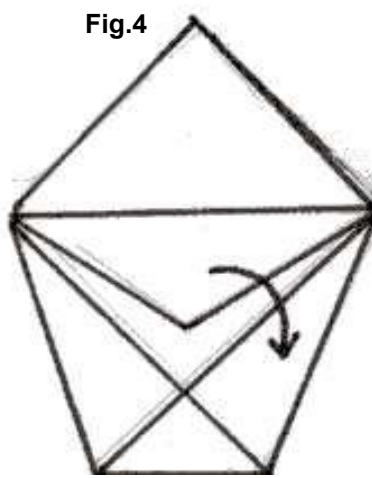
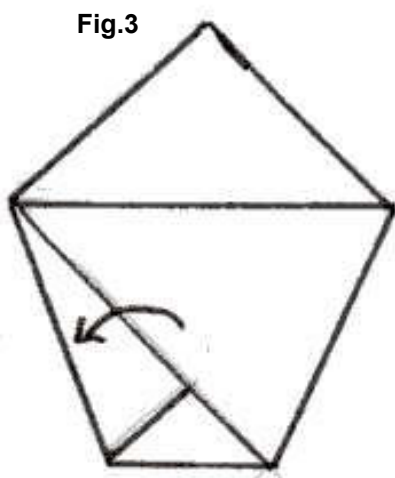
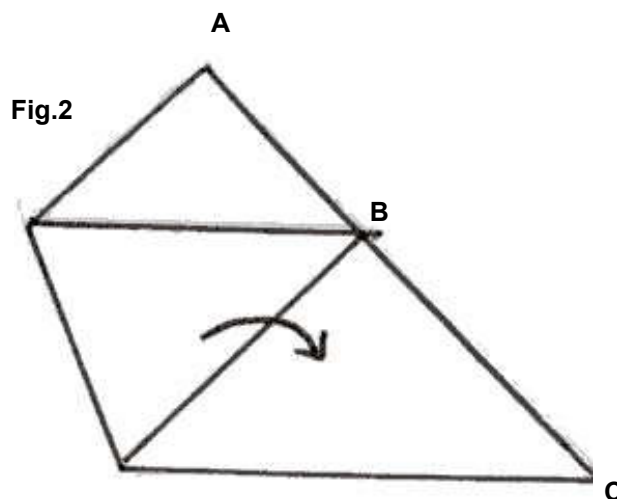
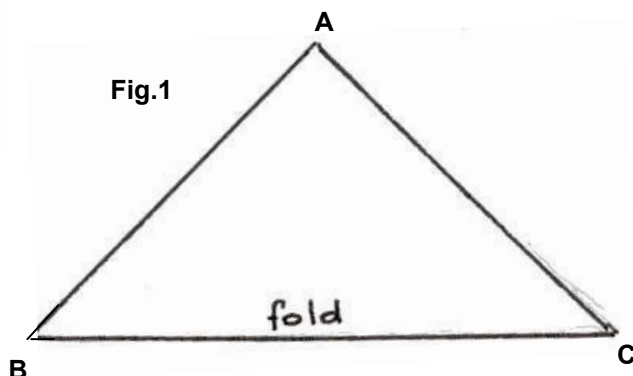
Fold a paper cup while telling the story of Jesus and the woman at the well (John 4), or Jesus at the last supper, when he took the cup...

LENT 2008:

Use this cup with the Living Water craft for Lent 3: the story of Jesus and the woman at the well (John 4).

1. Start with a square of coloured paper. Fold on the diagonal to make a triangle. (fig.1)
2. Take corner B and fold to the right, so that the top edge is parallel to the base of the main triangle. (fig 2)
3. Take corner C and fold left in a mirror image of the previous fold. (fig.3)
4. Take front triangle only of the top triangles and fold over the bottom 2 triangles. (fig.4)
5. Take the back triangle at the top and fold it down over the back of the cup.
6. Insert fingers into cup and push outwards, flattening the bottom of the cup slightly so it holds its shape.

These also make nice cups to put a small gift in, or biscuits, nuts or sweets.
