


## Peace in the world starts with peace in your home


### Kindness and friendliness help people get to know one another:

- ☺ Don't help yourself to Mum or Dad's 'stuff' without asking first.




### Care for the environment and living things

- ☺ Find out about the worms, beetles, birds




- and butterflies in your garden.

- ☺ Play peacefully together.

- ☺ Turn off violent TV programs.
- ☺ Talk to Mum or Dad about what you see on TV.
- ☺ Watch your language: don't say rude, nasty and hurtful things to other people.



- ☺ Look after yourself: you are precious.
