Chrismon Crafts

Hanging Crib

the central image of Christmas: every Chrismon tree should have a crib

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Materials:

- thin card to photocopy stable scene onto (can be coloured, e.g. blue for night)
- 5 pop-sticks per child
- · ribbon for hanger
- colouring pencils or textas
- glue (glue sticks work fine on pop-sticks)

Method:

- Colour in picture.
- Cut around outline.
- Glue one pop-stick down each side of "stable" for walls, one across the bottom for floor, and two in a V shape across the top to form the stable roof. Try to get glue on both the ends of the pop-sticks and on the paper in between. Pop-sticks should protrude past the ends of the roof.
- Attach a loop of ribbon on the back at the top for hanging.
