MAKE

THE LARGE HEART

- 1. Fold on the dotted line
- 2. Cut out the larger heart, cutting front and back together
- to form a hinged heart.
- 3. Form a heart-shaped frame by cutting away the shaded heart on the front heart only
- 4. Insert a photo (or drawing) of your family; adjust it to the best position in the frame and glue it in place.
- 5. Trim away any edges of the picture that extend outside the heart frame.
- 6. Glue the front and back of heart together.
- 7. Use a needle to punch holes at the X's

ASSEMBLE THE MOBILE

- Thread string
 through the two top
 holes in the large heart
 to form a loop for hanging.
- 2. Thread a string through the hole in the small heart.
- 3. Thread the other end of the string through a hole on the large heart. Start in the centre; work to sides.
- 4. Cut the string to the length you want and tie off the string.

You can add one small heart to the mobile when you finish the activities for each week; or you can make it up all at one time.

MAKE THE SMALL HEARTS


- 1. Fold along the dotted lines
- 2. Carefully cut out pairs of small hearts that are back-to-back. Leave the top of each heart pair attached to the folded edge. You will have a hinged pair of hearts.


