

Spirit or Breath

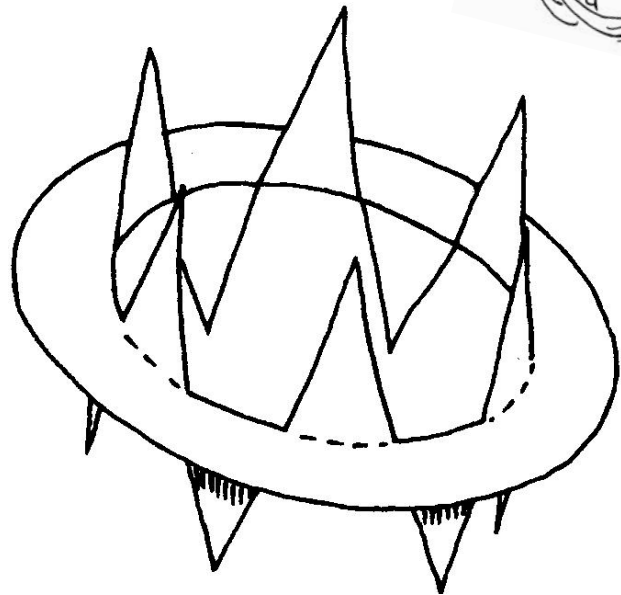
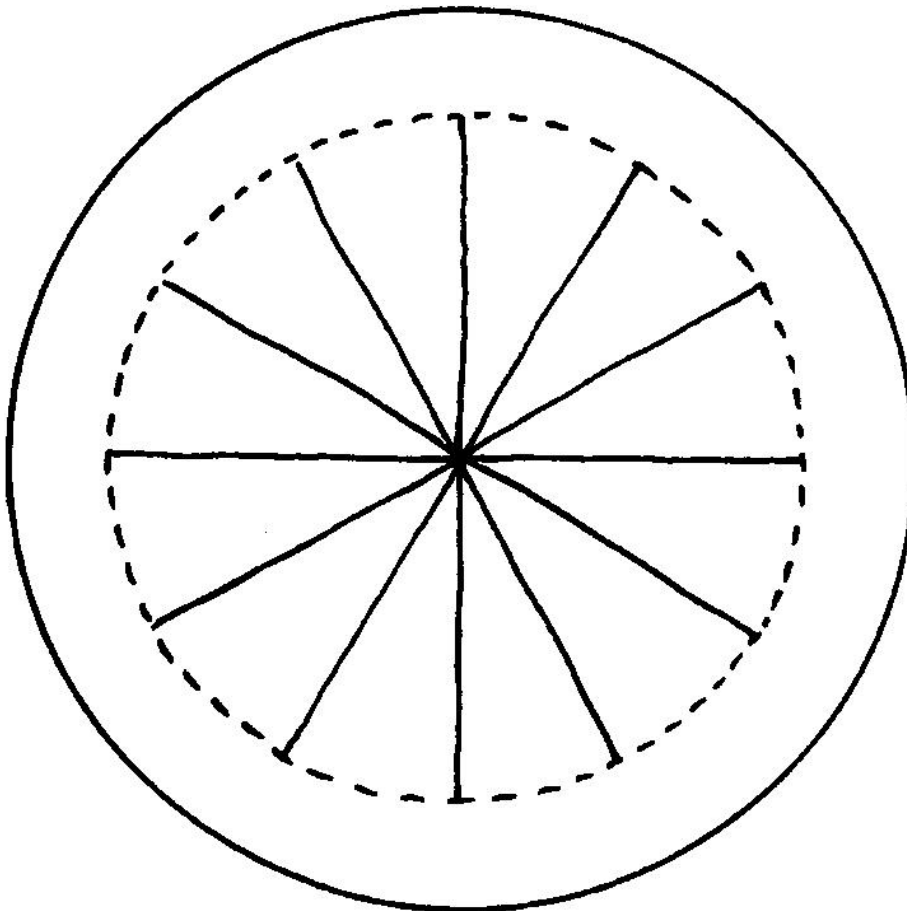
Breeze Ball Pentecost 'Spirit' or 'Breath' Ball

Materials:

- ◆ red, yellow or orange paper or thin card
- ◆ scissors, felt pens
- ◆ Pentecost sentence: e.g. Breathe on me, Breath of God

Preparation:

- ◆ Draw circle 12-14 cm in diameter
- ◆ Mark an inner circle 3cm in from edge.
- ◆ Mark 12 triangles as shown.
- ◆ Photocopy onto paper or card.
You can photocopy it with the verse included, or children can write it in themselves.



What to do:

- ◆ Cut out the circle.
- ◆ Write the verse around the edge if desired.
- ◆ Cut along the 12 straight lines starting from the centre. (Use a craft knife to get started or fold along one of the lines and start to snip.)
- ◆ Fold alternate triangles up and down so there are 6 triangles pointing up and 6 pointing down, alternating.
- ◆ Drop the ball on the ground where a breeze can catch it and watch it roll along.

This rolls very fast so don't let children take it outside near a road.
