Office hours	7:30am - 6pm staggered times can be arranged
Parking & transport	Where practicable, parking will be arranged
Office traffic	No standing meetings in corridors
Hot desking	No shared desks
Kitchen	Individual tea, coffee, biscuits (no biscuit jars) No shared cutlery Strict kitchen hygiene Paper towels only, no cloth tea towels Fruit to be washed by individual
Printing area	Strict hygiene, limited number of staff in the printing area
Meeting room	Strict hygiene, limited number depending room capacity

Student attendance	Pre-booked library access
Library	<b>From 9 June</b> , limited opening to individual student access between 10am - 3pm daily Pre-booked 1 hour limited time slots available up to maximum 5-6 students per day
Kitchen	No shared cutlery Strict kitchen hygiene Paper towels only, no cloth tea towels
Printing area	Strict hygiene, limited number of staff in the printing area
Meeting room	Strict hygiene, limited number depending room capacity
