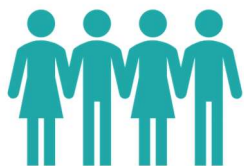

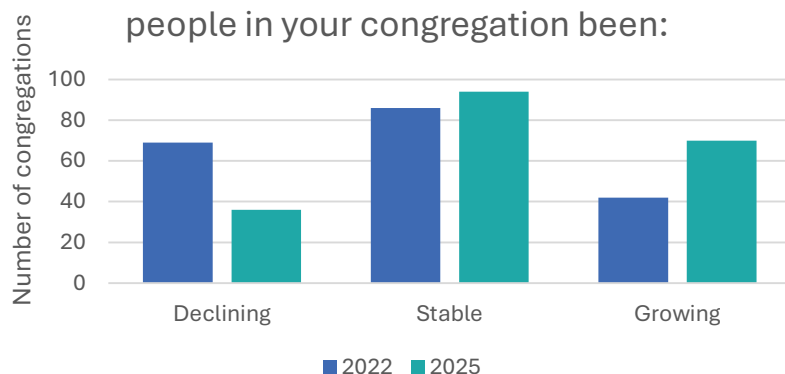

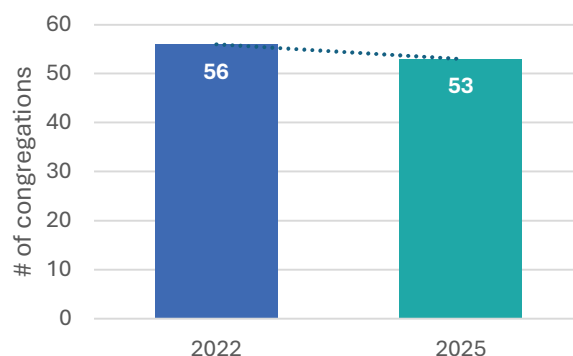
In the last 3 years, has the number of people in your congregation been:



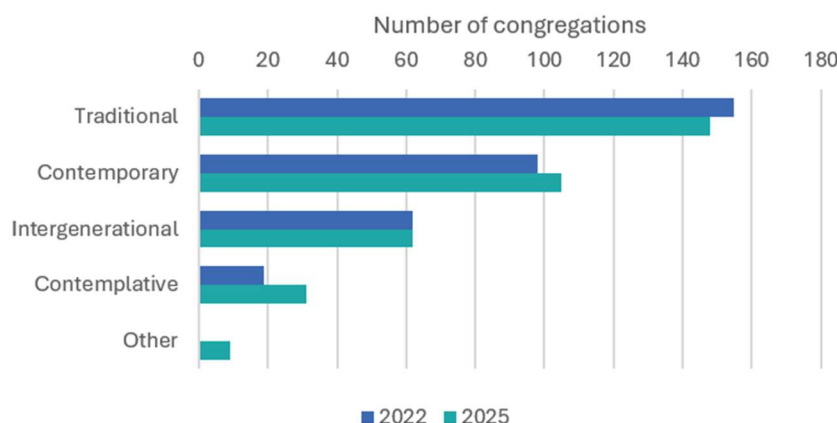

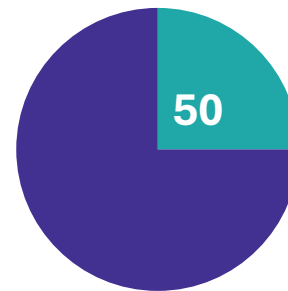

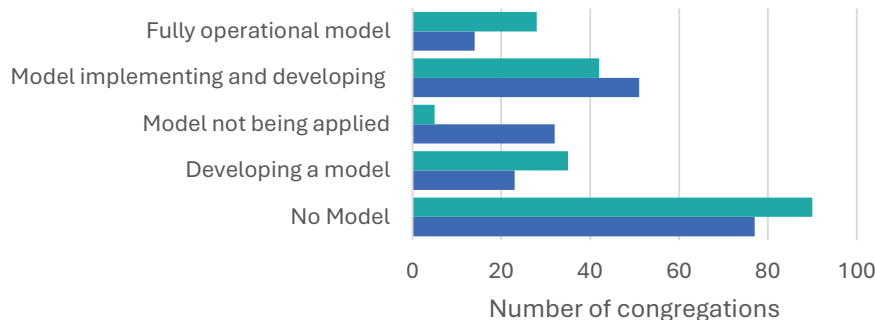

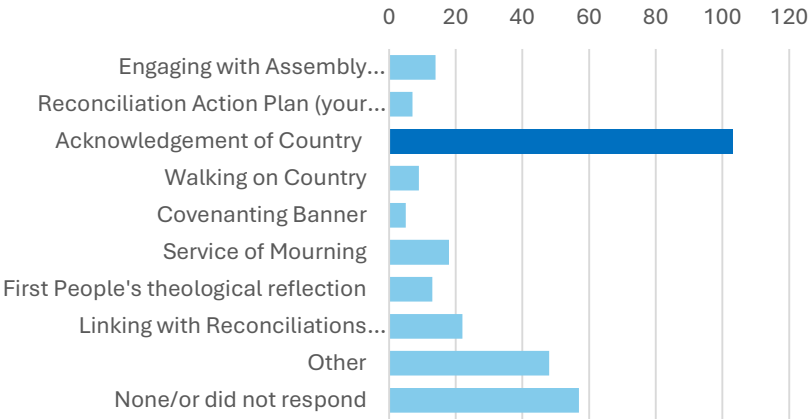

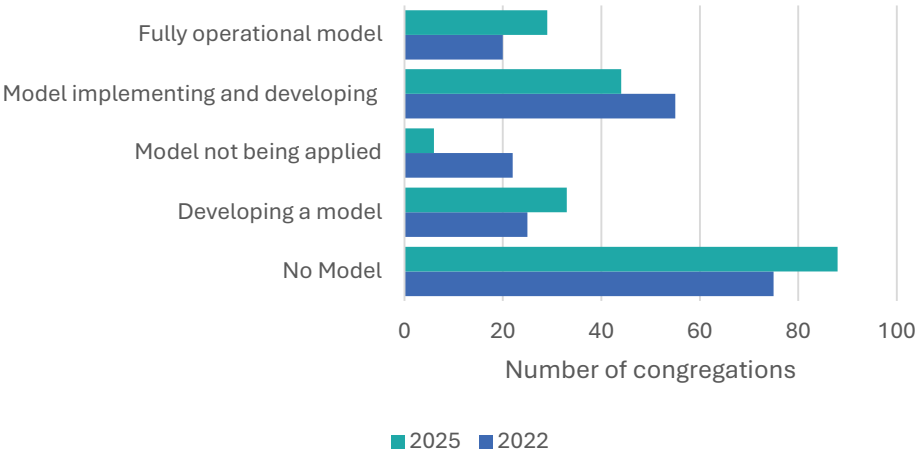

Congregation Engagement with Covenant and UAICC



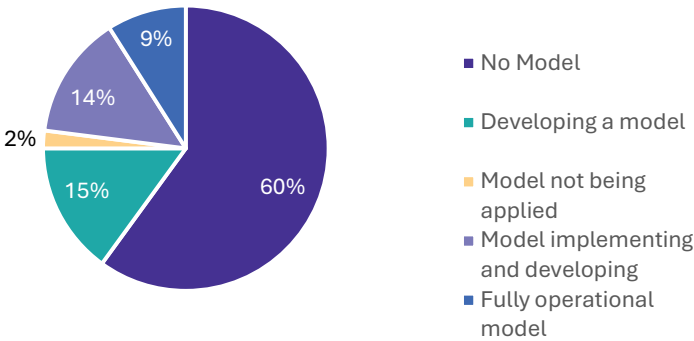

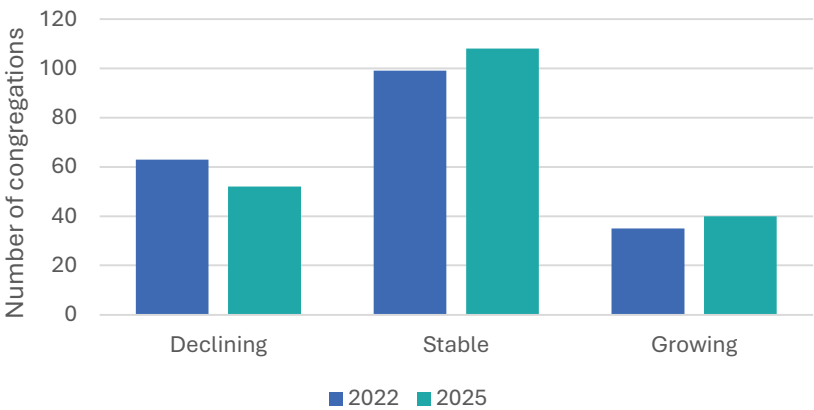

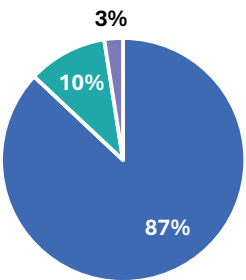
